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

Surgical/Procedural Ramp Up Phases

Phase 1 - 4/29

(High Priority)

Outpatient

Regional/Local Anesthesia (Block)

Urgent/Emergent

Phase 2

(Normal Priority)

Outpatient/ Extended Observation

Inpatient (limited)

General Anesthesia (limited)

Procedure cannot wait >2 months

Phase 3

(Low Priority)

Outpatient/ Extended Observation

Inpatient/ ICU

General Anesthesia

Elective/ Urgent/ Emergent



Why phased escalation of cases?

- Limitations on PPE
 - Avoidance of AGP's and PPE requirements
- Medication shortages
 - Avoidance of certain meds utilized in general anesthesia cases
- Sterile surgical gown shortage

Continued Focus on Employee and Patient Safety
